

## **CALL FOR SELECTION OF COUNTERPARTIES FOR STATISTICAL TRANSFER OF ENERGY FROM RENEWABLE SOURCES, AS PROVIDED FOR BY ARTICLE 6 OF DIRECTIVE 2009/28/EC.**

The article 6 of directive 2009/28/EC sets the possibility for Member States to make arrangements for statistical transfer of a specified amount of energy from renewable sources from one Member State to another Member State, in the light of the achievement of national and European targets for the production of energy from renewable sources of energy by 2020.

In particular, Italy reached its domestic target for 2020 so that a part or the whole surplus of energy from RES can be transferred to one or more Member States, in line with the implementing provisions of the article 58 of the Law Decree n. 76/2020 (converted into Law n. 201/2020), without prejudice of the achievement of the Italian target.

Italian surplus of energy from RES for 2020 in respect of the gross consumption is expected to be about 38 thousand GWh, considering that the mandatory target for Italy is of 17% up to 2020 and that it is going to reach about the 20%.

The present non binding call is intended to explore expressions of interest coming from Member States or from EU regions that cannot achieve their national 2020 targets; the Ministry will evaluate and, in case of positive evaluation also under economical criteria, select one or more counterpart for negotiating and signing an intergovernmental agreement.

The amount paid for the transfer of the agreed quantity of renewable energy shall be assigned on a bank account in favour of Cassa per i Servizi Energetici ed Ambientali and shall be used for the reduction of the general costs of the energy system or for research activities in the energy sector, in accordance to the rules settled by the Italian Regulatory Authority upon Ministry's guidelines; specific objectives for the revenues of the transfer can be agreed with the Member States or with EU regions inside the Italian general environment/energy targets up to 2020 and 2030.

Member States or UE regions interested in statistical transfers can contact competent offices of the Ministry for ecological transition or through the permanent representation or through diplomatic channels, expressing the interest in starting a deal.
