

Modiano was born in Rome on October 29<sup>th</sup>, 1964 and graduated from the University of Rome in Political Science in 1989. He entered the diplomatic career in March 1992. Since 1995 he has served at the Presidency of the Republic in the General Secretariat at the Office of Diplomatic Affairs. He was first commercial secretary in Santiago and Pretoria, where he was subsequently confirmed as commercial advisor. Returning to Farnesina, (the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs), he was appointed embassy advisor in July 2007 and head of Office V of the Generation Cooperation and Development Direction. In 2008 he became first counselor for emigration and social affairs in Buenos Aires, confirmed in the same location as first counselor, at the end of 2010. After being in Cairo, where he was promoted to plenipotentiary minister in 2015, he returned to Rome. On a first time he responded directly to the General Director for Globalization on Global Issues, then, out of role he served at the Presidency of the Council of Ministers, as head of the delegation for the organization of the Italian presidency of the most industrialized countries' group. Since August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 he is Deputy General Director for Globalization and Global Issues and Central Director for Global Issues.
