## WHAT'S THE ISSUE?

The Covid-19 pandemic, persistent inflation, soaring energy prices and a projected slowdown in GDP growth have placed roadblocks on the path to achieving the SDGs. Progress is falling short on almost 50% of the SDG targets, and 37% of SDG targets are either stagnating or regressing, including on key targets such as those related to poverty alleviation, hunger eradication and climate action.

As part of the OECD Programme A Territorial Approach to the SDGs, this webinar will take stock of major strides that cities and regions have achieved to localise the SDGs. Delving into key policy areas affected by recent crises, the discussion will explore how the SDGs can serve as a powerful tool to counteract the adverse impacts on the cost-of-living, energy affordability and food security.
