HCFC PHASE-OUT MANAGEMANT PLAN For the supply of refrigeration equipment and tools to training centers in The Islamic Republic of Iran, 150200-1-06-01

General Background Information and Objective of the Project

The HCFC Phase-out Management Plan (HPMP) for the Islamic Republic of Iran was approved in the 63rd Meeting of the Executive Committee of the Multilateral Fund held in April 2011 and revised at the 74th Meeting. The Agreement between the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran and the Executive Committee of the Multilateral Fund for the reduction in consumption of Hydrochlorofluorocarbons in accordance with the stage II of the HCFC phase-out management plan was made at the 77th Meeting of the Executive Committee of the Multilateral Fund.

The Government of Iran proposes to use low GWP HC based technologies in foam sector wherever feasible. The Government after careful and thorough consultations with the industry recognizes the importance of safety while adopting flammable alternatives in different applications and in their strategy, would adopt measures to ensure that the alternatives are adopted in a safe manner.

Project Objective

The objective of this project is to assist the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran to ensure the sustained reduction in the use of HCFCs in the refrigeration and air-conditioning manufacturing sector by facilitating access to information through extensive training activities so as to achieve the 75% reduction target by 2023 of the Montreal Protocol.

Expected Outcome

Provision of training equipment and educational aids to TVTO to a total of 6 centres: The costs of the equipment for the training centres have been approved for Stage II. While this equipment will be part of UNEP component, it will be procured by UNIDO on behalf of UNEP and the funding will be included in the UNIDO component:
