Description:

The United Nations World Water Development Report (WWDR) is the UN system's main authoritative report on water, providing decision-makers with the critical knowledge and the tools necessary to formulate and implement sustainable water policies and actions. Launched annually on World Water Day (March 22nd), this year's edition, entitled "Partnerships and Cooperation for Water", is uniquely poised to inform and inspire the dialogues and deliberations scheduled to take place at the UN 2023 Water Conference. Building on the report's findings, this side event will highlight relevant experiences at local, regional and national levels in Italy as well as in other countries. Nearly every water-related intervention involves some kind of cooperation: occurring across local to global scales, through formal and informal arrangements, water partnerships bring together a variety of stakeholders with different objectives and perspectives.

The side event consists of three sections:

- i) Institutional Opening, which includes remarks from Italian Minister of Environment and Energy Security H.E. Gilberto Pichetto Fratin, from Deputy Director General of UNESCO Mr Xing Qu and the UN Water Vice Chair Mr Johannes Cullmann, and the presentation of the WWDR2023's main messages and findings to inspire the discussion to follow;
- ii) Panel (1) with the UN WWDR's lead authors (Panel-1), where the UN agencies and other organizations expand on sectoral aspects related to interactive dialogue theme IV;
- Stakeholders Panel (2), a cross-sectoral discussion that focuses on concrete experiences at local, regional and national level of partnership and cooperation from Italy and other countries, including gender and youth-inclusive partnerships and cooperation, and cross-sectoral examples from Italy's voluntary commitments for the Water Action Agenda. The Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation in partnership with FAO-Mountain Partnership, Republic of Kyrgyzstan, Republic of Tunisia and Aga Khan Agency for Habitat, present the initiative "AQUA TEAM for Sustainable Development", Italy's commitment to the Water Action Agenda. A Q&A session will follow the panel discussions.
